Checklist

- ☐ 1. Walk through each room and write down winter clutter, repairs, and deep-cleaning areas
- ☐ 2. Declutter closets, entry storage, pantry shelves, linen storage, and under-sink areas
- ☐ 3. Dust ceiling fans, vents, blinds, lamps, baseboards, door frames, and high shelves
- ☐ 4. Wash windows, tracks, screens, curtains, washable rugs, and throw blankets
- ☐ 5. Deep clean kitchen appliances, cabinet fronts, pantry shelves, and trash bins
- ☐ 6. Scrub bathrooms, grout, drains, exhaust fans, storage shelves, and shower edges
- ☐ 7. Vacuum under furniture, rotate mattresses, and reset bedrooms for warmer weather
- ☐ 8. Sweep patio, porch, garage entry, outdoor furniture, and seasonal storage zones

Planning note

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Tips

Start with a whole-home scan

Before cleaning, walk through each room and write down clutter zones, repairs, winter buildup, and outdoor areas that need attention. The scan keeps the spring cleaning checklist practical instead of endless.

Clean from high to low

Dust ceiling fans, vents, lights, shelves, blinds, and trim before wiping counters or mopping floors. Working top down prevents you from cleaning the same surface twice.

Pair cleaning with seasonal reset tasks

Spring cleaning is a good time to wash windows, rotate linens, clear entry storage, refresh outdoor furniture, check screens, and remove expired pantry or medicine items.

Common questions

What should a spring cleaning checklist include?

A spring cleaning checklist should cover decluttering, dusting high and low surfaces, windows, appliance interiors, closets, bathrooms, floors, outdoor entries, and any seasonal repairs.

How do I make spring cleaning manageable?

Split the checklist by room or by weekend. Start with decluttering, then dust from high to low, clean wet areas, finish floors last, and rotate outdoor tasks based on weather.
